- Sugar (bags for the centre or sachets for food parcels)
- Decent quality instant coffee (Caffeinated please)
- Squash
- Spreads: Peanut butter, Marmite, jams and marmalades
- Baked beans
- Single-serve packets that people can make with boiling water. For example; pasta sauce, noodles, cup-a-soup
- Individual juice cartons
- Wrapped bars/biscuits, such as Kit Kats
- Reusable bottles/flasks
- Socks
- Gloves
- Hats
- Razors
- Conditioner (we have enough shampoo)
- Handwash
- Hairspray
- Hairbrushes (we have enough combs)
- Laundry detergent tablets/pods
- Vouchers for shops like Argos or multi-store gift cards are always welcome to help people when they move into a home.
- We always need new or good quality tents and sleeping bags to help people who are sleeping rough.
